

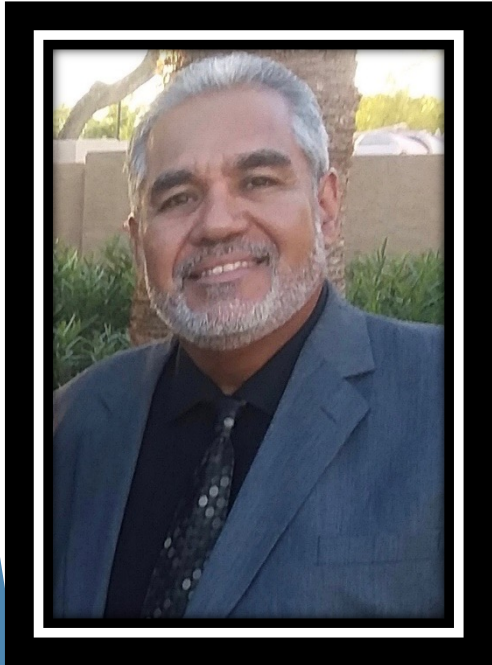

# Response to Intervention

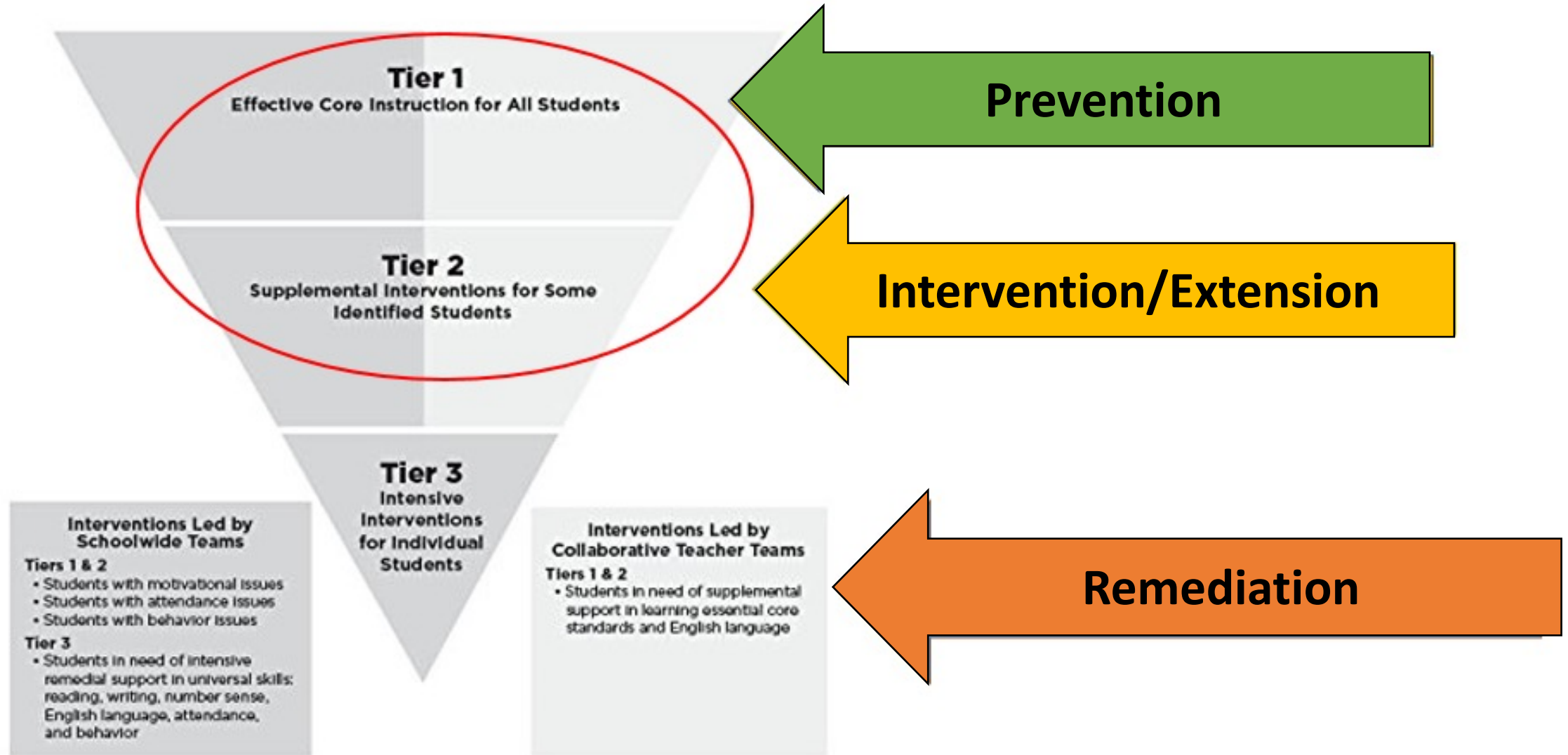


Figure 1.3: Team responsibilities in the Inverted RTI pyramid.

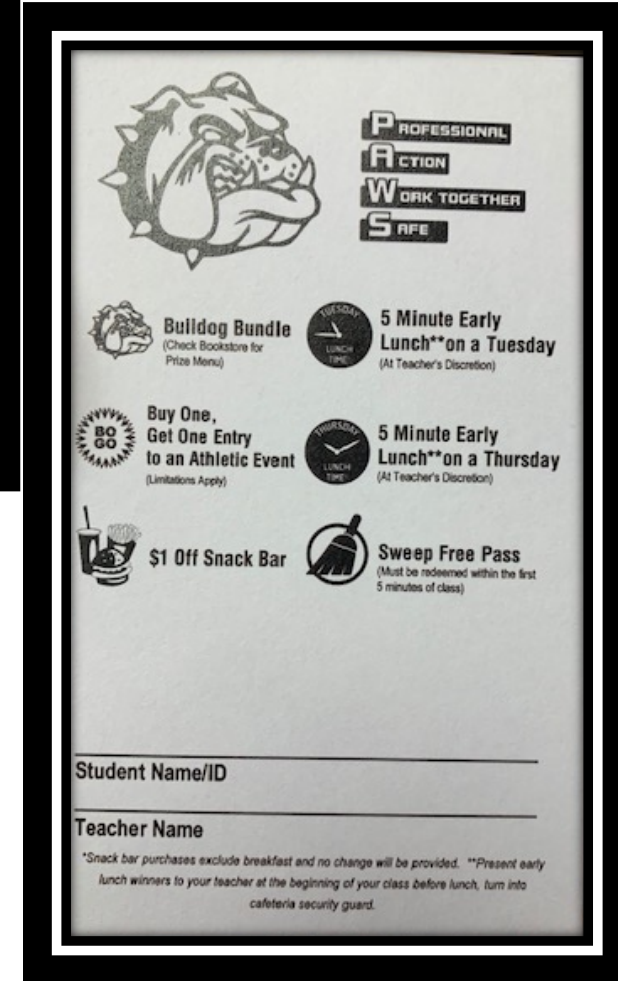

# Positive Reinforcement: PAWS Cards

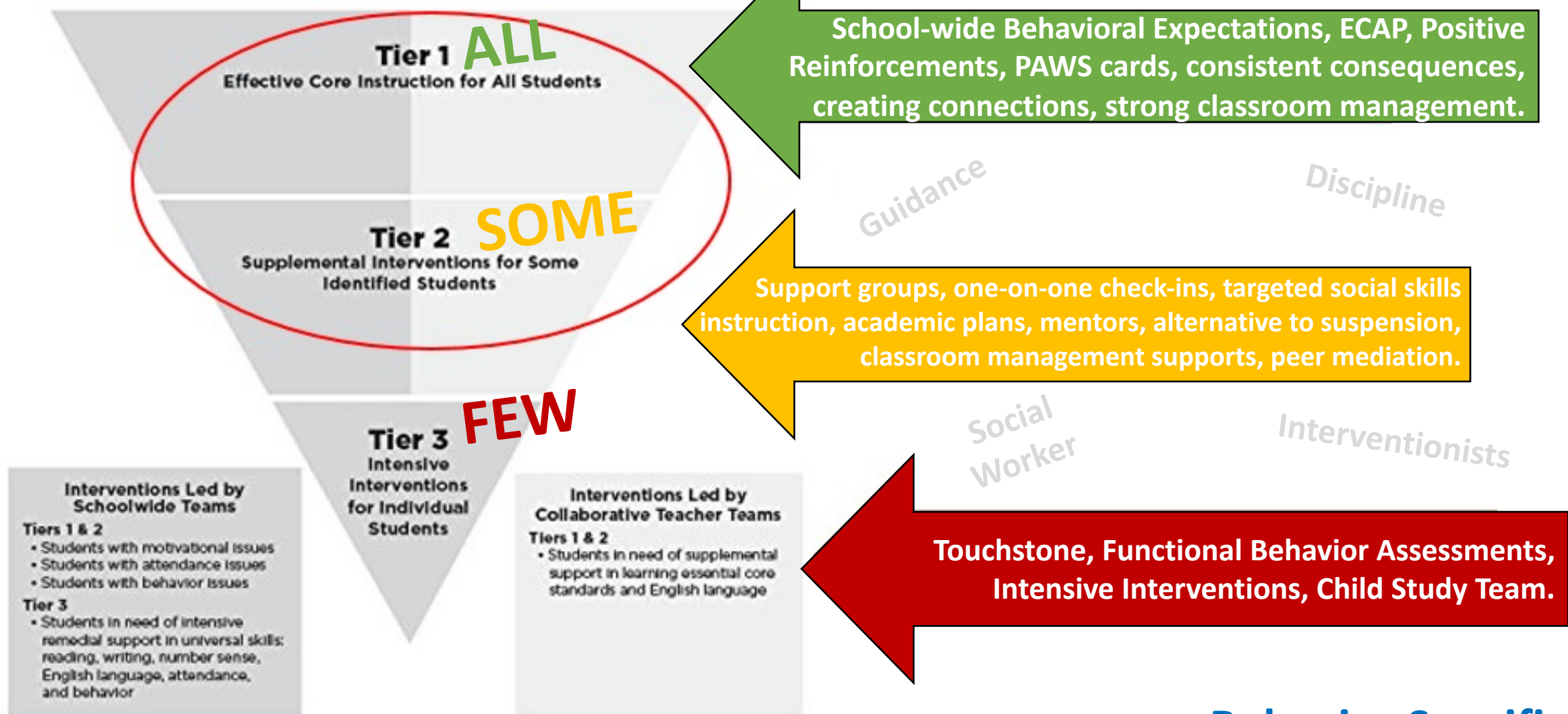


- **PAWS cards** are given to recognize students doing well.
- **PAWS cards** cannot be asked for, and it isn't a reward or bribe.
- **PAWS Cards** have incentives on the back or can be used to buy special items in our lunchtime 'pop-up' shops: **SLHS bling, school supplies, water bottles, fanny packs, and spirit items every Wednesday at both lunches.**
