Bookstore Information:

- Seniors will be notified in May regarding books they have checked out to them and any debts owed.
- All outstanding debts (lost books, lost athletic equipment, class fees, etc.) to the school must be paid to the bookstore <u>prior</u> to graduation rehearsal.
- If a book has been lost, a bookstore receipt for full payment of the book is necessary to clear the debt. All books and fees must be cleared by Friday May 20th.



Guidance Information Cont.

- Requests for transcripts can be made in the Guidance Office by scanning the QR Code in the Guidance office or through the school web site.
- Please report any and all financial aid, scholarships and admission acceptance letters to your counselor as soon as possible, so we can include it at our Scholarship Night for seniors by May 5th. Scholarship Night is May 13th



Graduation Requirements:

Finals	Senior finals will be May 18th, 19th & 20th. These will be part of your final grade, so make sure you are present.
Requirements	Meet all graduation requirements before the Friday prior to graduation. If you have taken any classes elsewhere, we must have official transcripts by May 6th.
Debts	Pay off all debts owed in the bookstore by May 20th
Practice	Attend and actively participate in graduation practice, May 23rd
Behavior	Model exemplary behavior from now until graduation.

SENIOR GRADUATION TIPS

We are in the final stretch of your senior year. Whatever your circumstances are at this point, we want to support you in obtaining your diploma and being on a path for a bright future.

- 1. Make sure that you do all you can to obtain the credits for all of the courses you are currently taking. Talk to your teachers, utilize all of your class time, attend FLEX and after school tutoring, and any other opportunities. We will have a Senior Saturday on April 30th from 8:00 AM-12:00 PM.
- 2. If you are behind in graduation requirements, work with your counselor to sign up for summer school. We will have a summer graduation ceremony. TEAMS chat/email your counselor to register. If you are currently enrolled in Credit Recovery (Edgenuity courses) you can continue working on those courses in summer. But if you choose to attend in person classes, we can help you register for that too. (During summer school, you be able to complete courses in 8 days.)

Note: (Seniors must register through their counselor. Do not follow the directions to register using ParentVUE).

- 3. If you have received any scholarships and/or awards, let your counselor know. We will be celebrating you at the Scholarship Night May 13th in the PAC.
- 4. Make sure you are set up for your next steps. Whether you are going to college or a career path, we have lots of resources and support to help with that transition. Take advantage of the opportunities and assistance available. There will be a College and Career Fair April 28th 5:30-7:30 PM in the Gym with employers from around our community ready to hire responsible workers.
- On Thursday, April 14th all seniors will meet in the PAC right after period 3 for a Senior Meeting with lunch following. If you are not in an all senior class, ask your teacher to excuse you 5 minutes early.



GRADUATION CEREMONY

- Your graduation status does <u>not</u> depend upon participation in the Commencement Ceremony. This is a privilege for those who conduct themselves appropriately.
- Graduation is on Tuesday, May 24th at 4:30 pm the State Farm Stadium.
- No purses, balloons, backpacks, camera bags, food/drink, or any other articles will be allowed in the stadium. Graduates are to bring their cap and gown with them.
 After graduates arrive, staff will assist students with the proper cap/gown placement.
- All must follow the safety protocols and guidelines required.*
- Parents and guests can start arriving at State Farm Stadium 45 minutes prior to the ceremony.

Appropriate Dress:

- You must purchase your cap, gown, and tassel from Jostens.
- Each gown also comes with a medallion.
- Only NHS sashes, honor chords, and *Native American traditional cultural regalia are permitted with the gown.
- You may <u>not</u> decorate your cap/mortar board.
- All clothing should complement the academic regalia, such as the items listed below. Any clothing that draws attention to the individual and/or away from the assembled class is not acceptable.
 - Tasteful dresses, preferably that do not show below the lower hem of the gown.
 - Dress slacks
 - Dress shirt
 - Dress shoes or boots. Make sure your shoes are comfortable to walk across the stadium floor, up stairs
 across the stage and downstairs.


